

# Additional Fees & Expenses

**Capital Fund Donation** The Capital Fund Donation is a payment made by all families of new students and is considered the first step to the enrollment of their children at Graded School. This donation goes toward facilities, computers, network infrastructure, equipment, labs, and other capital assets. <b>English Language Learners Services</b> (Participation determined through assessment for grades 1 – 10)	Non-native English speaking students will be given an English assessment at the beginning of the school year. If it is determined that your child requires English Language Learning support (ELL) there will be a charge of R\$12,000 (twelve thousand reais) for the 2018-19 school year. A separate yearly contract for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years will be issued as soon as the need is identified and confirmed.

<b>Materials Fee</b>	Although your tuition will cover most books and school materials, as well as lunch, several activities and special classes will require a separate fee. Costs for materials or activities are subject to change.
<b>Classroom Without Walls</b> (Grades 6– 12)	These trips are a required aspect of our curricular programs and all students are expected to attend. Costs for these trips will be passed on to parents and billed upon parental approval.
<b>Field Trips</b> (All School)	Costs for field trips and/or co-curricular trips will be passed on to parents and billed upon parental approval.
<b>After School Activities</b> (Optional All School)	Many activities are free of charge. The charge for any paid activities will be provided at the start of each semester. Some activities/clubs have trips associated with them – there is a separate charge for these trips.
<b>Additional Books/Digital Resources</b> (Grades 6-12)	Several reading books are purchased by students to use for reference, note taking and class discussion. Digital resources are also used in some classes.
