

JANET SALLOUTI FINANCIAL AID AWARD

The Janet Sallouti Financial Aid Endowment was created to support children of Graded alumni, bridging the financial gap between the tuition and fees of Graded and other top Brazilian schools. The application for The Janet Sallouti Financial Aid Award is separate from the regular Graded admissions process. We will only consider applicants for the Financial Aid Award who have been accepted to Graded.

Pre-award Eligibility Requirements:

Alumni families that prove financial need.*
Students who exhibit academic, artistic, or athletic merit.
Students applying to grades 6 - 12.
Accepted to Graded via the regular Graded admissions process.

Priority will be given to **new students applying to Graded**. In the absence of qualified new applicants, current students will be considered.

Terms

- 1. For the 2020-21 school year, we will have **one** Janet Sallouti Financial Aid Award recipient.
- 2. The first recipient of The Janet Sallouti Financial Aid Award will be notified in April 2020 for the academic year 2020-21 (beginning August 2020). The deadline to apply is **March 30, 2020**. At present¹, the endowment allows for one recipient beginning in August 2020 and one recipient beginning in August 2021.
- 3. The award will cover 40% of monthly tuition for the entirety of the student's academic career at Graded. Eligibility for the award begins in grade 6. Financial aid will apply for as long as the student remains in good academic and behavioral standing, which will be reviewed annually along with the family's eligibility. Graded

4. The Janet Sallouti Financial Aid award does **not** cover additional fees and expenses.

5. The endowment will absorb the Capital Fund Donation

The Capital Fund Donation (at present R\$60,000²), the first step of the enrollment process at Graded School, will be absorbed by the Janet Sallouti Financial Aid Endowment.

Maintain continuous attendance as stated in the Handbook.
